Format:

Half-FITA

18 Arrows shot at each of FOUR distances.

The Two long distances are shot on a 122cm target.

The Two short distances are shot on a 80cm target

Rules:

National Field Archery Association Rules and National Archery Association rules apply. The Nutmeg State Games staff reserves the right to combine equipment classes if there is not sufficient representation in each class. Competitor's age is determined by their age on January 1st, 2010. Participants will complete a 600 Round from their assigned distances. At the completion of the 600 Round the top 4 finishers in each age division will compete in an elimination bracket: 1st Seed vs. 4th Seed & 2nd Seed vs. 3rd Seed. The two winners will then compete for the Gold Medal and the two non-winners will compete for the Bronze Medal.

The Opening Ceremonies will begin as athletes from across the state participate in the traditional Parade of Athletes. Other special festivities will lead to the lighting of the ceremonial flame in true Olympic fashion, as the Nutmeg State Games are declared officially open.

DIRECTIONS:

Hungerford Park, New Britain, CT

From New Haven, CT:

Take I-91 North. Take exit 22 N to merge onto CT-9 N toward New Britain. Slight left at CT-571 W (signs for CT-71/CT-372/Kensington). Make a U-turn at Connecticut 71A S. Destination will be on the right.

From Danbury, CT:

Take I-84 East. Make a slight left at CT-72 E. Take exit 7 for CT-372/Corbin Ave. Make a Slight right at CT-372 E/Corbin Ave. Continue to follow CT-372 E. Continue onto CT-571 E. Destination will be on the right.

From Springfield, MA (North):

Take I-91 South entering Connecticut. Take exit 32A to merge onto I-84 W toward Waterbury. Take exit 35 on the left to merge onto CT-72 E toward CT-9/New Britain/Middletown. Take exit 7 for CT-372/Corbin Ave. Slight right at CT-372 E/Corbin Ave. Continue to follow CT-372 E. Continue onto CT-571 E. Destination will be on the right.

From Rhode Island (East):

Take I-95 South entering Connecticut. Take exit 69 to merge onto CT-9 N toward Essex/Hartford. Slight left at CT-571 W (signs for CT-71/CT-372/Kensington). Make a U-turn at Connecticut 71A S. Destination will be on the right.
