HOW TO MEASURE:

All measurements should be taken with a cloth tape measure and while wearing only a leotard. Do not add to the measurement for growth.

Chest: Around the fullest part of the chest.

Waist: Around the natural waistline.

Hips: Around the fullest part of the hips.

Girth: Starting at the shoulder in the center, bring the tape measure down the front, through the crotch, and up the back to the same place on the shoulder. Be sure that the tape measure is pulled up tight through the crotch.

This is the most critical measurement.

Please note that the girls and the adult sizes cross over in measurements between Child 12 and 14 and Adult XS and S. Child sizes are cut for a child's body and adult sizes for a developed body. A child 14 is actually longer but narrower than an adult XS.
